

Did You Know?

- It's an offence to ask for proof of medical exemption
- Government guidelines states you should <u>NOT</u> challenge members of the public for proof
- Members of the public are <u>NOT</u> required to display a lanyard or proof of exemption from a GP
- Refusing entry based upon a disability is an offence which <u>YOU</u> are personally liable for
- Company policy does <u>NOT</u> supercede the Equality Act 2010
- Legal action will be taken against those who discriminate against someone with a medical exemption and carries a fine from £900 to £9,000
